



### How to find us

Grange-over-Sands is approximately 20 minutes by road from exit 36 of the M6, following the A590 and B5277.


Upon entering the town, take the first exit at both mini-roundabouts on Main street, to the Esplanade. Thornleigh is on the right-hand side, Morecambe Bay on the left.

If travelling by train change at Lancaster to Grange over Sands. There is a direct link from Manchester International Airport, Manchester Piccadilly and Oxford Road stations. Thornleigh is 2/3 of a mile from the station. There is an uphill walk but taxi's are usually available from the station.

For over forty years Highway Trust has been welcoming individual guests and groups to Thornleigh Hotel, which is on the Esplanade, boasting views of Morecambe Bav. in the Edwardian resort of Grange-over-Sands.
