












TIME OF FELLOWSHIP - BAMBOO THEOLOGY

BOOKING CONDITIONS 2019

Payment and acceptance of a deposit constitutes a legally binding contract. A non-refundable deposit of £80 per person per week, £40 per child, is required to confirm a booking. Bookings made less than 4 weeks in advance require full payment at the time of booking.

ACCESSIBILITY Thornleigh is an accessible hotel and provides a hearing loop system in the lounge. Guests unable to escape the hotel, in the case of an emergency, must be accompanied by a relative, friend or carer.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE Accommodation is available from 3pm on the day of arrival and must be vacated by 10am on the day of departure. Cases can be stored with prior arrangement.

CANCELLATION CHARGES Sadly we have to apply charges to all cancellations. We are a charity and late cancellations severely compromise our budget as well as depriving others of the opportunity to come on holiday. We therefore recommend you take out travel insurance or be prepared to bear the following charges: Up to 8 weeks prior to the date of arrival, the non-refundable deposit only; less than 8 weeks 50% of the total amount due, 100% within 4 weeks of the expected date of arrival.

CAR PARKING Thornleigh has car parking to the rear and along the side of the hotel. Car parking is entirely at the owner's risk.

DINNER, BED & BREAKFAST The rate includes a three course dinner with coffee, served at 6.30pm, bed and breakfast served at 8.45am.

A supper tray can be provided for late arrivals and a breakfast tray can be prepared for an early departure, with prior arrangement. No refunds or reductions can be made for meals or accommodation booked and not taken.

DOGS/PETS We do accept registered assistance dogs. No other pets allowed.

HOSTS Most of our package style holidays are led by a volunteer host who will accompany excursions, organise social evenings, lead devotional times and say grace before meals.

INSURANCE We would advise guests to take out appropriate insurance to cover their stay in the event of cancellation.

METHODS OF PAYMENT Payments can be made by credit or debit card (except American Express). We can accept BACS payments, please contact the hotel 015395 32733. Please use your surname and date of holiday as the reference.

Alternatively you can send a cheque made payable to Highway Trust Limited.

PRICES All prices stated on the package holidays are for our standard en-suite accommodation, if you wish to upgrade to a Bay-view room the charges are £15 per room per night and, subject to availability, if you request a double bedded room for single occupancy, the supplement is £10 per night, £25 per night in a Bay-view room.

SPECIAL DIETS We can cater for most special diets, with prior knowledge.

VAT Vat at 20% is included in the prices shown but will be charged at any rate applicable at the time of payment for the holiday.
